Day 1: Tuesday 16th September | The Right Bank - Saint-Émilion

Arrival & Transfers: Guests may arrive independently in Saint-Émilion, or group transfers will be arranged from Bordeaux-Mérignac Airport based on flight arrival times.

Lunch - La Terrasse Rouge: Dining at Château La Dominique, overlooking the prestigious vines of Jean-Faurie and Château Cheval Blanc.

Winery Tour - Château Cheval Blanc: A private visit to this iconic Premier Grand Cru Classé 'A' estate.

Historical Exploration: A guided walking tour of the medieval village of Saint-Émilion - a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Evening Transfer: A scenic drive across the peninsula to the Médoc (approx. 75 minutes).

Dinner & Accommodation: Check-in and dinner at Château Clarke or Golf du Médoc Resort.

Day 2: Wednesday, 17th September | The Left Bank - The Médoc

Morning - Château Cos d'Estournel: A tour and private lunch at this Saint-Estèphe estate, renowned for its exotic, oriental-inspired architecture and "super second" status.

Afternoon - Château Mouton Rothschild: A visit to the legendary Pauillac estate to view the Great Barrel Hall and the famous "Art and the Label" museum.

Downtime: A brief return to the hotel to refresh and relax.

Evening - Château d'Issan, as the guests of M. Emmanuel Cruse, owner Chateau d' Issan:

Private Tour: An intimate look at the moated 17th-century château in Margaux.

Hosted Dinner: An exclusive dinner held within the historic halls of the Château.

Day 3: Thursday, 18th September | Bordeaux City
